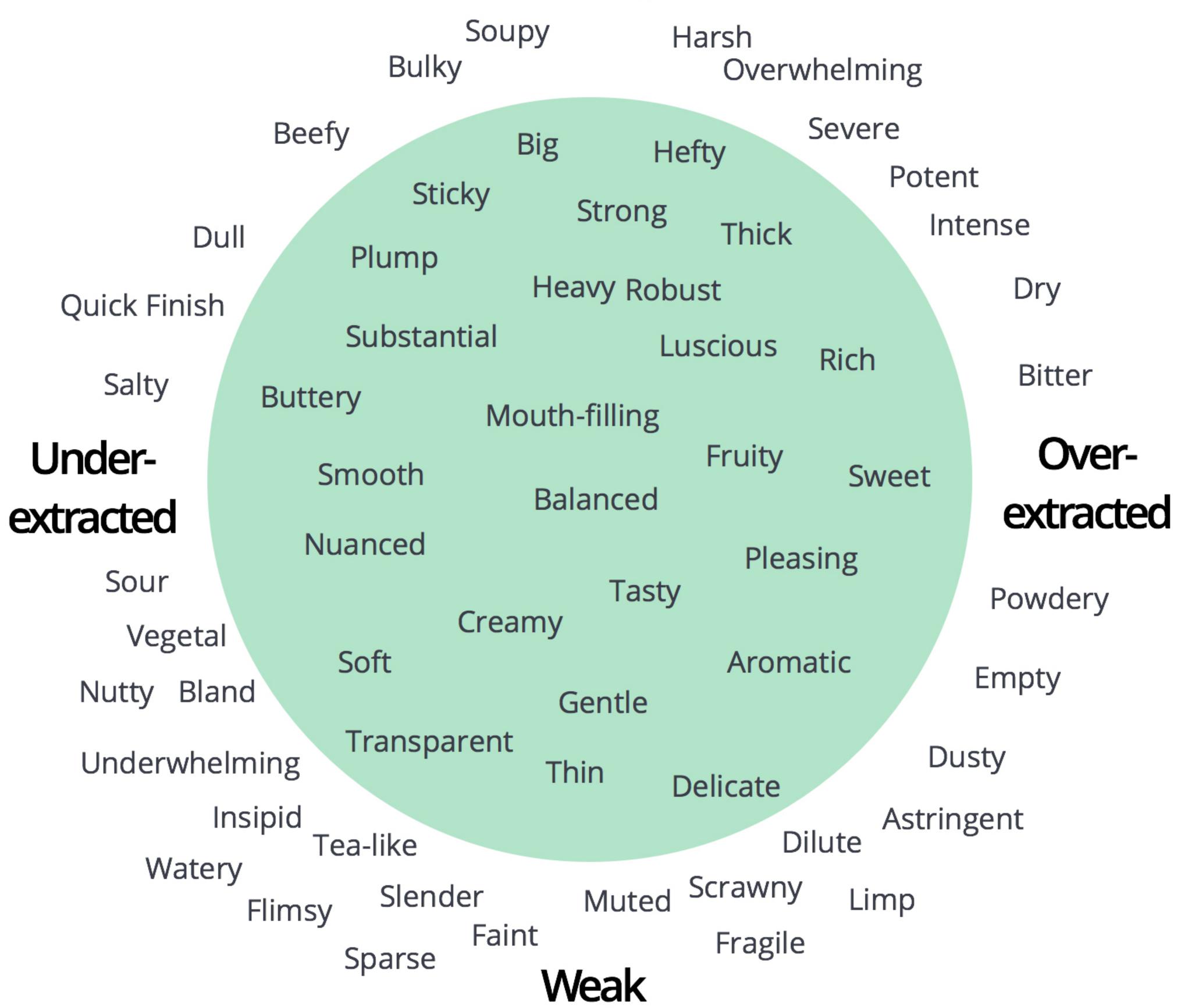
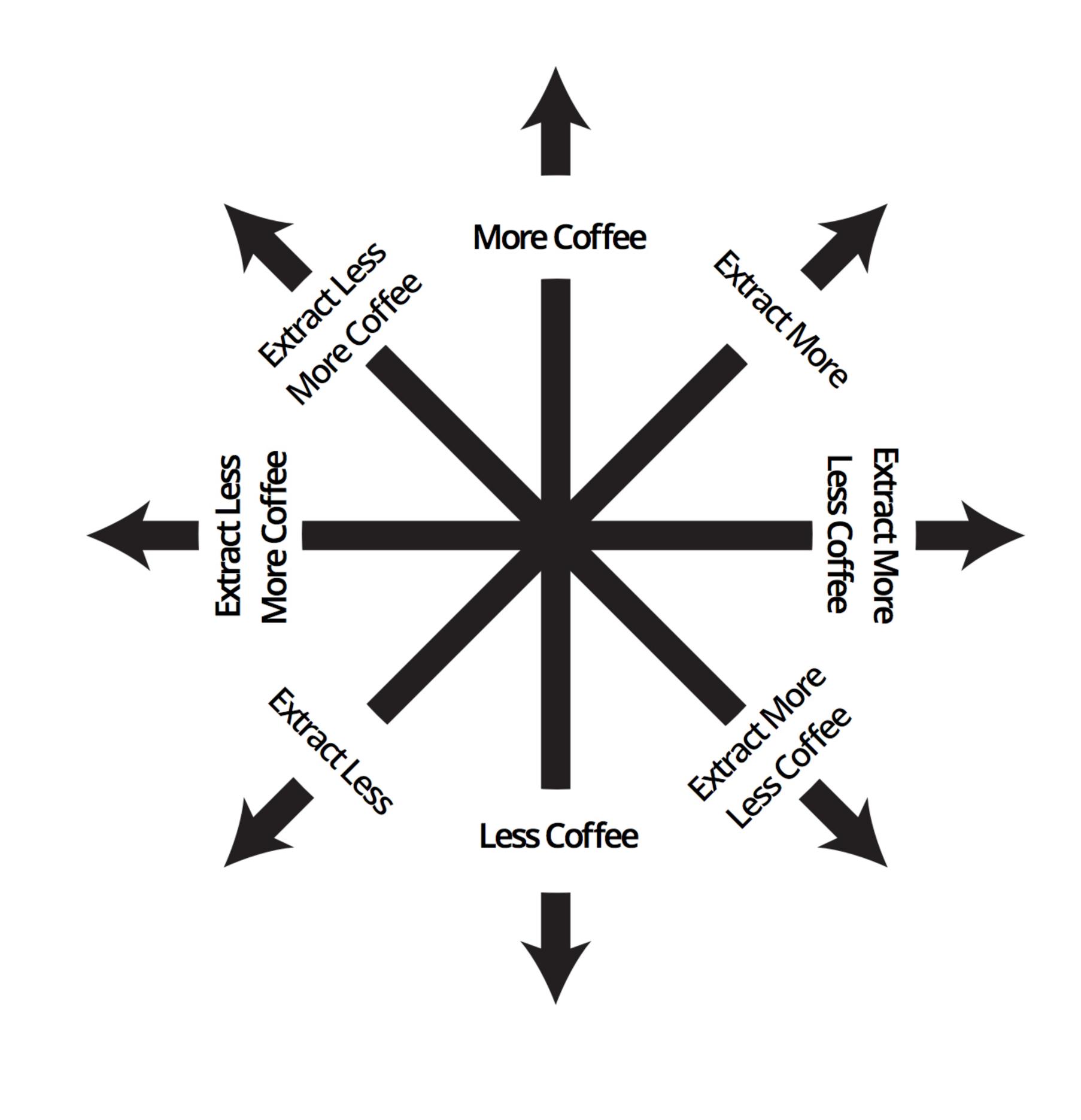
The Brewed Coffee Compass

1. Use the map to find where your brew sits. That spot is the center of the compass.

- 2. Use the compass to travel back towards the green zone.
- eg. To travel away from an underwhelming, watery, and sour brew, extract more.
- To travel away from a heavy, salty, and sour brew, extract more and use less coffee.

N.B. When adjusting brewing ratio, I recommend fixing water weight and adjusting dose. This will make brewing times and final brew volume more consistent.

Extract More

Finer Grind and/or Longer Brew Time

Extract Less

Coarser Grind and/or Shorter Brew Time

Less Coffee

Higher Brew Ratio
This can be achieved by fixing water weight and reducing dose OR by fixing dose and increasing water weight.

More Coffee

Lower Brew Ratio

This can be achieved by fixing water weight and increasing dose OR by fixing dose and reducing water weight.
